Port Lympne Hotel & Reserve

Port Lympne Hotel & Reserve is located near Hythe in Kent. Set in 600 acres, and housing over 650 rare and endangered animals, Port Lympne is a unique award-winning experiential experience. Delegates learnt about how Port Lympne, part of the Aspinall foundation had evolved and now plays an important role in animal conservation globally. The Aspinall Foundation's founder, John Aspinall, dreamt of reintroducing gorillas bred at Howletts and Port Lympne back to the wild almost as soon as he started collecting and breeding them in the early 1970s. Today, this dream is being carried forward by his son, and current chairman, Damian Aspinall, who sees the reintroduction of animals into their natural habitats as a vital part of conserving wildlife and their habitats globally. Over the past few years alone, the "Back to The Wild programme" has introduced 8 black rhino, 49 Javan langurs, 9 Javan gibbon, 11 European bison and over 60 western lowland gorillas back to their natural habitats. - https://youtu.be/mNYILJwZPkI.

- Underlining the costs of financing this conservation programme, the speaker explained how the park had moved away from just being an animal park for day visits into an experiential experience where visitors could get up close to animals and even stay on site in the park.
